

FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The recipients of the UW Sheboygan scholarships are chosen by the *Student Aids, Awards and Appeals (AAA) Committee*, or in some cases, the organization providing the scholarship. The AAA Committee is made up of three faculty/staff members, two students and one non-voting member of Student Services. Most scholarships are awarded for one academic year with one-half distributed upon first semester (Fall 2009) registration and one-half distributed upon second semester (Spring 2010) registration. Scholarship awardees will be recognized at Honors Convocation on Tuesday, May 5, 2009.

As you complete your scholarship application, remember to respond to all of the questions. Write "NA" (not applicable) if appropriate. Recipients of the various scholarships will be determined based on the information provided on the application form. Although most scholarships are awarded primarily for academic achievement (minimum cumulative 3.0 G.P.A.), other considerations, such as extra-curricular activities and financial need, play an important part in the selection process. The *Student Aids, Awards and Appeals Committee* reserves the right to interview any and all applicants.

Students receiving financial aid are eligible to apply for scholarships since scholarship funds are separate from those used by the UW Colleges Financial Aid Office. Students are also encouraged to check with Student Services for additional scholarship opportunities which are not administered by this campus.
